6. Announcements

- A. Shields Valley Christmas Fair and Festival of Trees
 - a. Parade on Friday, November 29. Same route as last year. Requested use of town fire truck for Santa to ride in the parade. Clyde Park Rural Fire will be solicited to drive the truck and has agreed to handle traffic crossings at 89.
 - b. Adding lights on trees in the Park and on the Pavilion
 - c. No business front decoration contest this year
- B. Recap of Mayor's attendance at the MT League of Cities and Towns Annual Meeting
- C. CSO Danysh has completed an inventory of the Fire Hall. This will be sent to the attorney working on the Interlocal Agreement with Clyde Park Rural Fire to begin drawing up the agreement.
- D. Congratulations to newly elected Council Members Carol Amunrud and Joshua Koch. A third Council Member will be appointed for the remainder of the third open position. The swearing-in ceremony will be at the December meeting.
- E. Animal and Business License renewals are due by December 31st.
 - All animals owned within the town limits are required to be licensed (pets) or permitted (livestock)
 - b. Those who have recently registered their cats do not need to re-register them.
 - c. Stay tuned for an announcement for a free pet portrait with registration event at the Town Hall. We are seeking a volunteer photographer for the event.
- F. The speed signs have been placed on First Street at both ends of the school reduced speed zone. In addition, we will be adding yellow striping in those zones to help slow traffic speed (weather permitting).
- G. There will be a new Food Resource Center called the "Back Alley Food Bank" behind Glenn's Market. The owners are looking for assistance with finishing the remodel. Donations can be brought to the store or monetary donations can be made at Bank of the Rockies in Clyde Park.
- H. The Mayor was approached by Park County Emergency Services Director Greg Coleman to seek permission to include the town in an application for the use of remaining ARPA Funds (federal/county) being submitted by a consulting firm to provide broadband access to the Municipal Office from an emergency services grant under the BEAD act (federal project to expand access to unserved and underserved areas.)
- Glenn's Market in conjunction with Crazy's are contemplating planning a park fundraiser in January called the "Frosty Frolic" on Miles Avenue between the businesses and the Community Center. Music, Chili, Hot Chocolate, Dancing and street games are being discussed.
